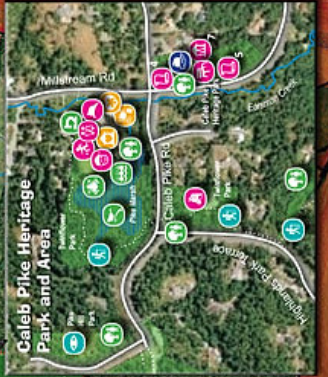


Highlands Community Green Map
